This belongs in it:

- → Newspapers and illustrated magazines
- → Folded cardboard cartons
- → Packing paper without adhesive tape
- → Catalogues and leaflets
- → Exercise books
- → Unbound books
- \rightarrow Letters and envelopes
- → Forms and computer paper
- → Clean paper sacks
- → Paper packaging
- → Cigarette packs without aluminium paper and foil
- → Chocolate boxes without plastics.

This belongs in it:

- → Fruit and vegetable remainders
- → Potato peels, egg shells
- → Coffee filter bags, Tea bags
- → Wilted flower bouquets
- → Potted plants (without pot)
- → Garden wastes such as leaves, grass, weeds
- → Tree and shrubbery cuttings
- → Garden mould
- → Paper handkerchiefs
- → Paper napkins, household paper
- → Crumpled newspaper sheets to absorb moisture.

This belongs in it:

- → Diapers, sanitary napkins, Toilet papers
- → Plastic waste bags, Meat, bones and fish
- → Cooked food remainders and dressed salads
- → Vacuum cleaner dust bags
- → waxed papers, coated or dirty papers
- → Carbon and manifold papers. Foils
- → Wallpapers, carpeted floor scraps, dried paints
- → Street sweepings, ashes, Cigarette butts
- → Broken small appliances (Please bring batteries and storage batteries to the poisons mobile container or to the utilisation materials yards).

This does not:

→ Please throw coated papers, waxed papers, dirty papers, self-adhesive foil, carbon or manifold papers, toilet papers, sanitary napkins and diapers wallpaper scraps into the grey residual waste bin. Please bring milk and beverage packages to the utilisation materials islands or yards. The Telekom will take back telephone books.

This does not:

- → Please throw toilet paper, diapers and sanitary napkins, plastic waste bags, meat, bones, fish, boiled and liquid food left-overs, dressed salads, vacuum dust bags, ashes and street sweepings into the residual waste bin.
- → Please bring metal, glass and plastics to the utilisation materials islands (packages only) or to the utilisation materials yards.
- → We will chop up bulky tree and shrubbery cuttings in your garden.
- → Please bring stones and building rubble to the utilisation materials yards.

This does not:

- → Paper and cardboard, that's what the paper bin is for.
- → Biological wastes from kitchen and garden belong on your compost heap or in your bio bin.
- → Bulky tree and shrubbery cuttings will be chopped by us in your garden.
- → Please bring metal, glass and plastics to the utilisation materials islands (only packages) or to the utilisation materials yards. Please bring bulky waste and building rubble to the utilisation materials yards.
- → Please bring problem wastes such as paints, photo chemicals and solvents to the poisons mobile container or to the utilisation materials yards.
